


Index de Perception de la Corruption


‘Fraude’ ou ‘Corruption’ ?

“A fraudulent practice is any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation.”

“A **corrupt practice** is the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence improperly the actions of **another party**.”







Common fraud myths within the Non-Profits

“Our employees have been here for ages! No way they would steal! We trust each other. We would have identified misconduct by now.”

“It may happen in other places (e.g. corporates) but certainly not here.”

“Everyone in a Non-Profit is honest and has a charitable heart.”

“We are only a small Non-Profit with few employees. We therefore can't really have proper controls to mitigate the risk of fraud.”

“Auditors will detect any fraud incidents.”

“Our people will react if they see something unusual.”

“We are very well prepared and apply a ‘zero tolerance’ principle!”

“There are annual Risk & Compliance e-Learnings for our staff.”

“Our suppliers confirm in their contracts that they are compliant with our ABC regulations. There is no risk!”



Ex. complaints mechanism :

- Hotline to report any issue related to assistance
- Distribution in flyers + posters + content list
- Direct interaction between beneficiaries and volunteers/FO/Delegates, who were specially trained
- Objective is to spread knowledge (= assistance is free / criteria) + whistleblowing any misbehaviour (inclusion/exclusion “fees”) + adjust programs (quality/quantities) + ad hoc review of cases
- Extra tool in complement to registration, Post Monitoring, assessments, WhatsApp distribution group, distribution lists, internal controls, etc.
- Idea is not only to identify fraud, but more importantly, to ensure beneficiaries receive adequate assistance (which in turn, is an incentive to report abuses).

Uwajibikaji Pamoja Integrated Complaints Referral Mechanism At County Level

Quality service and accountability from Government and Non-Government service providers is your right.

"Uwajibikaji Pamoja" ("accountability together" in Kiswahili) is an automated web-based Integrated Complaint Referral Mechanism. The platform aims to improve quality and accountability of aid and is available to community members at grassroots level and facilitates the referral of complaints from one aid or basic service provider to another at the County level.

The service enables members of the public and organisations to submit and refer complaints concerning aid and service delivery to the relevant public and non-public authorities at County level, through a toll-free SMS line, email and walk-ins. People with no access to a mobile phone or internet may visit the nearest office of a partner organisation participating in the intervention or speak to their front-line staff on the field to lodge their complaints. The walk-in option also allows people who cannot read or write to report their cases.



“The ‘Uwajibikaji Pamoja’ platform aims to improve service delivery to the residents of Turkana, West Pokot and Wajir by facilitating the referral of complaints from one service provider to another.

The service enables members of the public to submit complaints or feedback concerning aid and service delivery through three channels:

- a **toll-free SMS line**,
- a **web-based portal**,
- by **filling out paper forms**.
- People with no access to a mobile phone or internet can visit the nearest office of a participating organisation to lodge their complaints.
- The **walk-in option** will also allow people who cannot read or write to report their cases.”


